A friendly creative workshop that combines walking, tea and writing!

This creative workshop combines walking, tea and writing and is spread over four sessions - one per week - and is entirely free, but booking is essential due to number limits - please read on for details:

Led by local writer and storyteller Sally Pomme Clayton, each session starts with a gentle guided walk through the cemetery. Pomme will then guide you with simple, fun and playful creative writing prompts based on the beautiful natural surroundings.

Explore how you can create your own stories and poems with her inspiring guidance.

Pomme is a warm and encouraging teacher, and the workshop is for all adults, regardless of experience. Follow her through the trees and enliven your imagination!

The four sessions each follow a different path and theme inspired by the cemetery, exploring nature, plants, trees, local history and ideas about beauty.
